

Sec. 16-40. - Fireworks or explosives.

No person at any park or beach shall bring in or have in his or her possession, or set off or otherwise cause to explode or discharge or burn, any firecracker, torpedo, rocket or other fireworks or explosives or inflammable materials, or discharge them or throw them into any such area from land or highway adjacent thereto. This prohibition includes any substance, compound, mixture or article that in conjunction with any other substance or compound would be dangerous from any of the foregoing standpoints.

This section shall not prohibit fireworks displays where permitted under the provisions of section 15-5.
